

Lockdales' Auction #277 Report: The Fine Sale: 9th November 2024

Total prices realised: £243,418 (incl. prem.)

Trending styles of jewellery include signet, masonic, sapphire & diamond, opal, pearl and eternity rings. Mixed jewellery and costume jewellery lots were fiercely fought over, bringing prices up to £4000 (20 times estimate!) for some groups. Likely some designer pieces in there, or unmarked yellow metal/gold.

Rolexes were sold up to £8500 for a “Kermit” Sub. Some of the standout vintage watch results included ‘quartz crisis’ extinct (or later resurrected) brands such as Marvin, Zenith and Universal Genève, with an El Primero restorers piece making £2600, and a Universal Polerouter reaching £2700. We also note increased interest in Breitlings. Some gold cased pocket watches sold well-above estimate at £2300 and £2500 for 18ct half hunters.
