

Lockdales' Auction #265 Report: The Banknote Sale: 4-5 June 2024

Total prices realised: £136,540 (incl. prem.)

Strong demand noted for certain countries including French Algeria, Belgian Congo, early Egypt, Greece, India – especially Portuguese Goa, and Pakistan. In the English sections we saw heavy interest in the error notes, such as O'Brien, Beale, and Peppiatt "fish tails". The sale began with a section of banking ephemera, where we witnessed some good results for security printers' colour charts and test notes.
